Wilding – the film

Reviews of the book were overwhelmingly enthusiastic, the film even better.

It is the story of 20 years implementing a decision to abandon conventional farming on a worn-out estate in West Sussex, after deciding and turn it over to nature. Like most simple ideas it needed managing and dealing with the authorities. What has been created is a haven for wildlife of all sorts, encouraging rare and returning species.

The scheme has benefits for all including neighbouring farmers whose crops are better pollinated and protected against damaging insects despite their early concerns. It has proved that life can return to a degraded landscape.

For wildlife, Britain is one of the most depleted countries in the world. A quarter of our mammals face extinction, but *the book Wilding, by Isabella Tree,* proves that it's not too late, left to its own devices nature can recover.

The film is a lyrical homage to the natural world and those who care for it. Nature filming at its best.

This review says it all: Wilding – a life enhancing experience


